## What is OASys?

### It is the way we assess you

- to help us find out why you offend
- to help us find out what your needs are
- to help us find out if you are likely to harm other people
- to help write a report about you for the Courts
- to help make a sentence plan
- to help you make changes to your life so that you are less likely to offend again

## What happens?

### You will

- have an interview
- be asked to complete a question sheet about yourself
- be able to discuss the way you see yourself and your offending
- be given a copy of the sentence plan
- have reviews to see what progress you are making

## What should you do?

### You should

- attend interviews and be ready to take an active part
- ask questions
- complete the list of questions about yourself
- think about your answers to the questions. This is your chance to comment on your life and why you offend. It is a chance for you to help plan your sentence
- comment on your sentence plan. The plan is about how we are going to work with you to make it less likely that you will offend again.
